



**A-140 NEW YORK and CONNECTICUT BUTTONS--effects of Confederate raid: A collage of Federal buttons recovered from the ruins of a sugar mill in Southern Louisiana. During the Teche Campaign, Federal troops from New York and Connecticut had managed to store their excess luggage in a big sugar mill warehouse along Bayou Teche. When they returned, they discovered the building had been destroyed by marauding Confederates. Everything had been burned, which explains the distorted condition of some of these buttons. Mounted in a black wooden shadow box, fittingly superimposed over a U.S. flag (copy).**
